Introduction:

NSS IITD has a volunteer base of around 2000+ students belonging to various disciplines of IIT Delhi. We work on a diverse range of social issues, including blood donation, education, and the environment. We also collaborate with different NGOs in and around IIT Delhi, working on relevant issues.

1. Statistics about total investment of human hours in social activities

A total of around 41000 hours of training were conducted by NSS IIT Delhi between August 2023 and July 2024. Out of them around 27000 hours came from one time events and 14000 came from NSS Projects. During this period, B.Tech students enrolled in NSS were required to complete a mandatory 80 or 100 hours of training, depending on their year of entry. On the other hand, participation for staff members was entirely voluntary, with no mandatory hour requirements, allowing them to engage in NSS activities based on their personal choice and interest.

NSS IIT Delhi has actively engaged in numerous impactful activities from August 2023 to March 2024, emphasizing health, education, environment, inclusivity, and innovation. Over 2000 volunteers contributed to initiatives addressing social challenges like blood donation, education for underprivileged communities, and environmental conservation.

Key activities included awareness sessions on blood donation myths, mental health webinars, and workshops promoting gender sensitivity and sustainable practices. Educational endeavors encompassed teaching projects such as "Bachpan" and "VIDYA," which provided academic and technical education to students from disadvantaged backgrounds. Health-focused events like blood donation drives and health camps benefited hundreds, fostering community well-being.

The annual festival, Kaizen '24, featured diverse programs, including panel discussions on leadership, social entrepreneurship, and inclusivity, alongside creative competitions and sustainability workshops. Notable events like the Freedom March and Unity Run celebrated national pride and community bonding, while outreach efforts such as the "Mera Pehla Vote" campaign and the Ujjwala Fest empowered marginalized groups.

Projects like "Jyoti" for visually impaired students, "Munirka Teaching Project," and refugee education under "Viaan" demonstrated NSS's commitment to inclusivity and empowerment. Environmental initiatives included plantation drives, sustainable design workshops, and campaigns to address air pollution, reflecting a holistic approach to social responsibility and development.

1.Aarohan

- **Description:**
