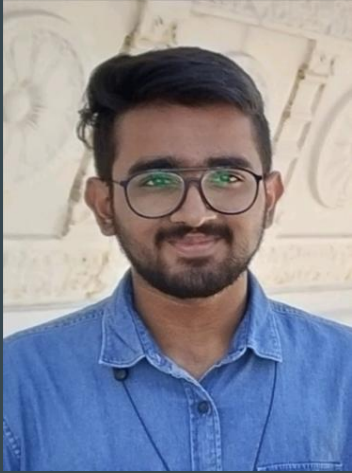

5. Ear Checkup and Eye Checkup in collaboration with OAE.

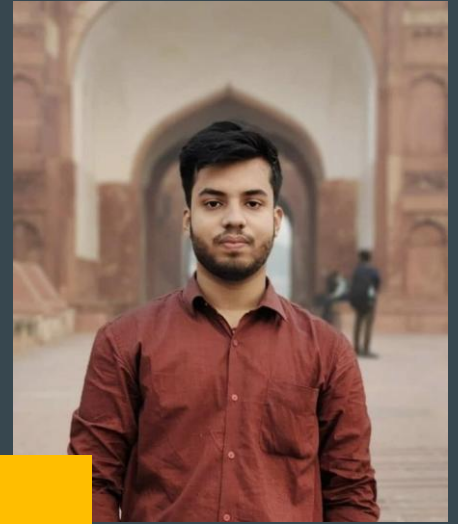
Future Goals

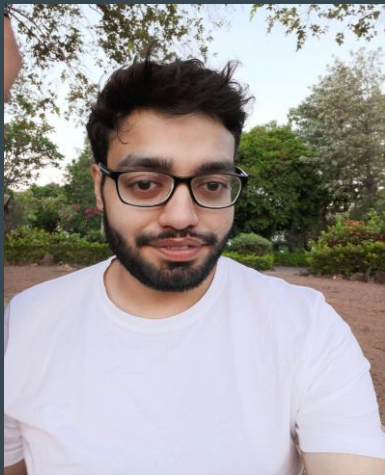

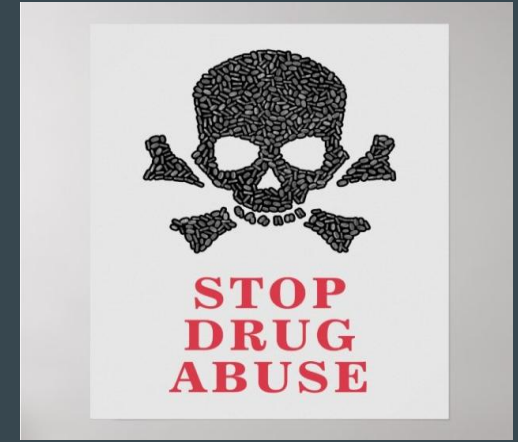

Finding rehabilitation center

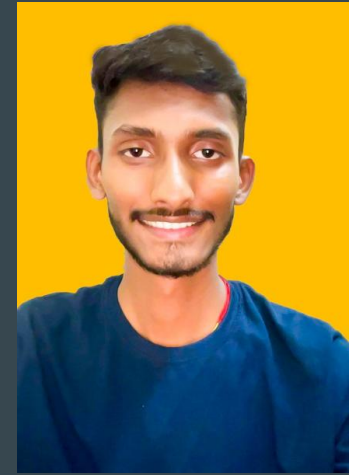

Our main aim is to promote blood donations and a healthy nation for which we try to spread awareness about various health related issues so that people can have a better “Jeevan”.

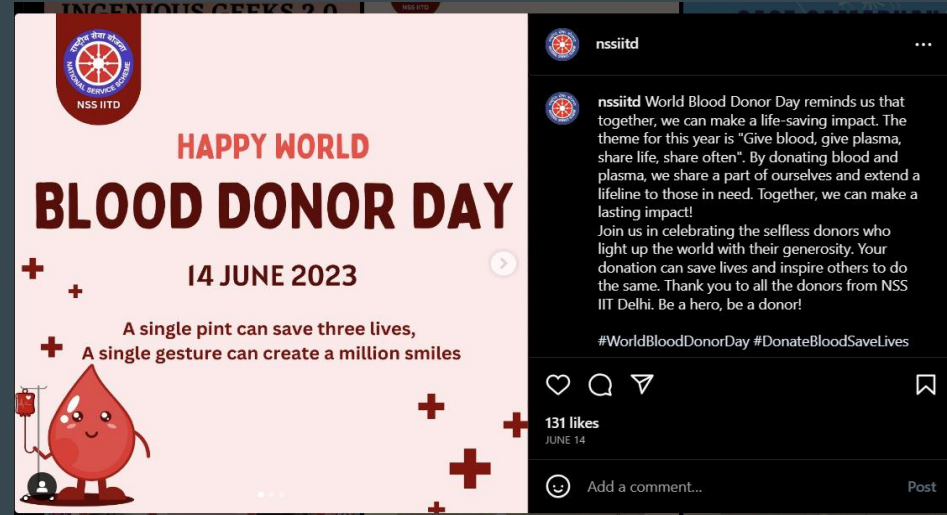
Work done

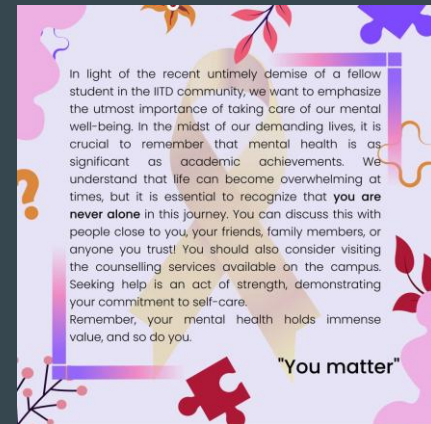

We discussed a number of ideas to name a few:

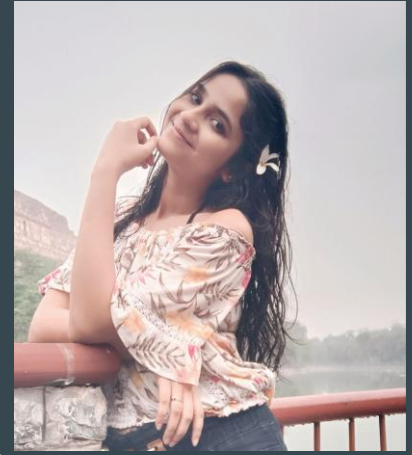
1. Drain Blockage - Dome-shaped structures built on drains will prevent blockage of drains by debris and ensure that the drainage system functions at its optimal capacity.

Moreover, we ensure the well-being of over 500+ animals of the campus, encompassing activities like feeding (mainly dogs) and offering aid in case of injuries.

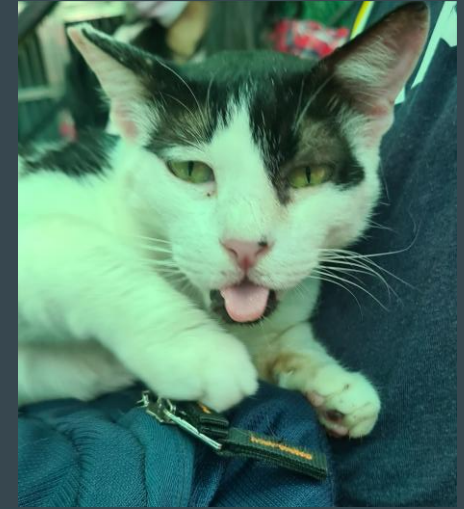


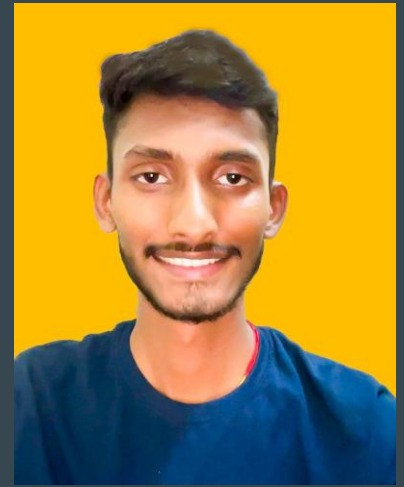
Work Done

3. Sustaining the interest of the students in academics so that they enjoy as well as gain useful knowledge while doing so.



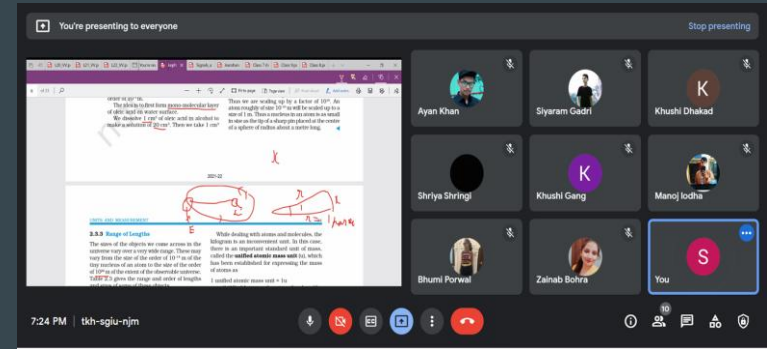
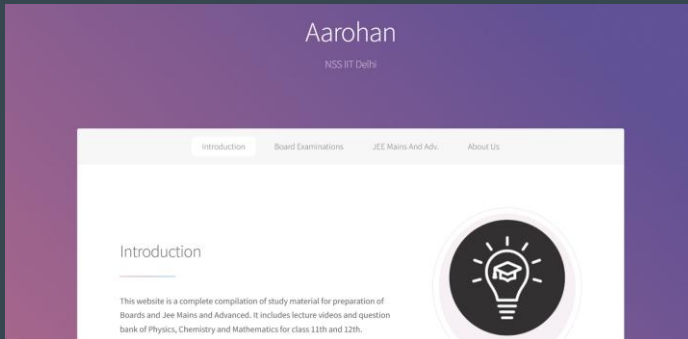

2. Expand the batches in the coming weeks and bring in more volunteers and beneficiaries.

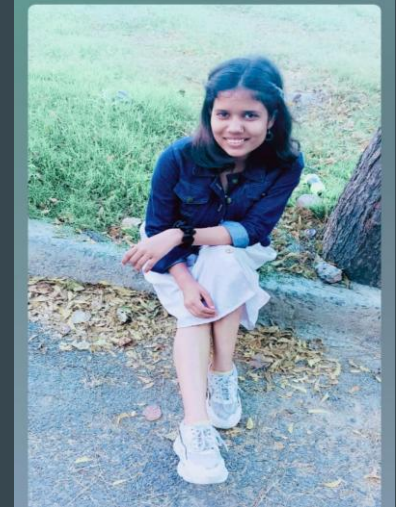

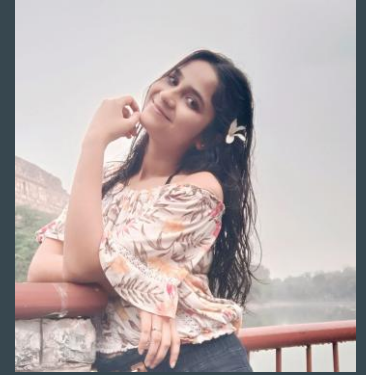
Work done

Future Goals

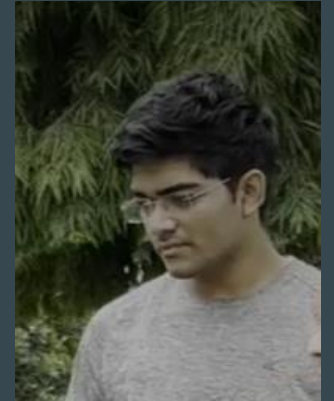
- 1. Phase 1 volunteering: To start regular volunteering from the coming weekend on priority.**

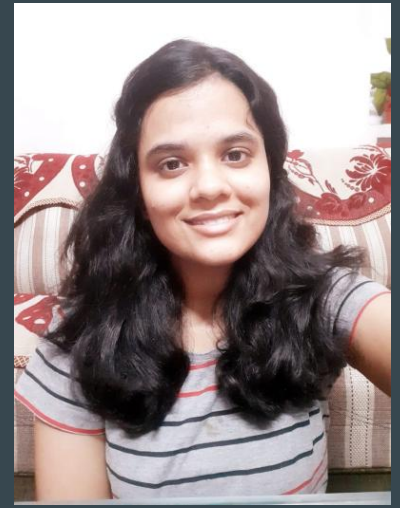

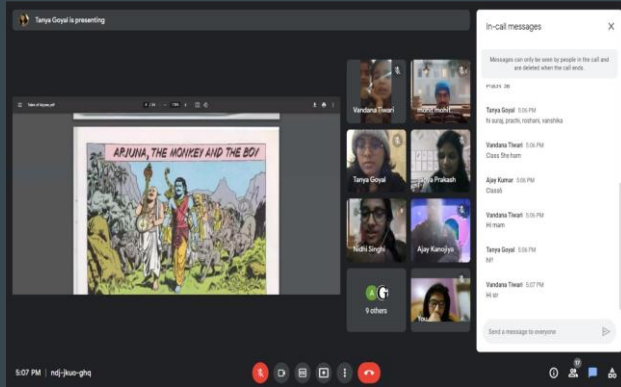

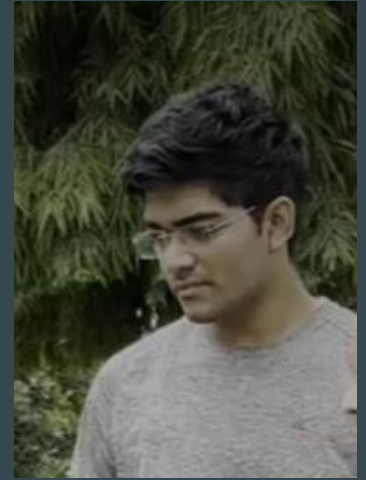


Work Done

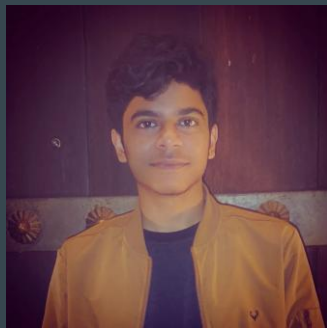
